Apparently our programme editor Graham White has a personal memory. His father took him to watch his first professional game at Luton Town on 6th April 1974.

The opposition was Preston North End, whose player-manager was Bobby Charlton and they also included another World Cup winner in their side - the late Nobby Stiles.

Graham remembers that Luton Town won 4-2 with the half-time score being 2-2 and that the Hatters centre-forward Barry Butlin scored a hat-trick. Unfortunately, he cannot remember if Sir Bobby scored for Preston North End.

The sad circumstances of Sir Bobby's passing has made Graham realise that it will be 50 years next April of watching his first professional game. Maybe a return to Kenilworth Road to celebrate - he has not been there since 1991. Too busy with the Brook House programme, he says.

Talking of Brook House, our performances have improved in the past 10 days with a battling performance against Langley despite suffering a 5-3 defeat. And a late equaliser from James Pilcher at Windsor earned us our first point for a while. And it was in difficult conditions.

GROUND REGULATIONS AT FARM PARK, KINGSHILL AVENUE, HAYES, MIDDLESEX, UB4 8DD TEL: 020 8845 0110

All persons entering the ground must comply with the following **Ground Regulations**.

Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the ground and a ban from attending any future events in the ground.

Admission and the right to remain within the ground is on condition that all persons refrain from the following acts:

1. Failure to comply with any legal directions given by a club official, steward or police officer.
2. Entering the field of play before, during or after the game.
3. Using obscene or abusive language.
4. Making racial or other forms of abuse.
5. Consuming alcohol in bottles, glasses, cans or any other container within the ground boundary. The taking of drugs or being under

the influence of drugs.

6. Climbing on any building, wall, fence or floodlights.

7. The use of horns, hooters or any musical instrument that will affect the enjoyment of others.

8. No animals permitted in the ground with the exception of guide dogs.

9. The throwing of any missile, object or projectile.

In addition all emergency exits, walkways and approaches to the ground must be kept clear at all times.

The club committee reserves the right to amend, add to or update these regulations as and when necessary.

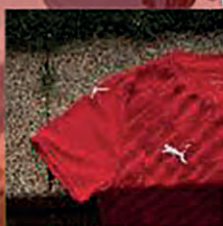

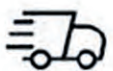

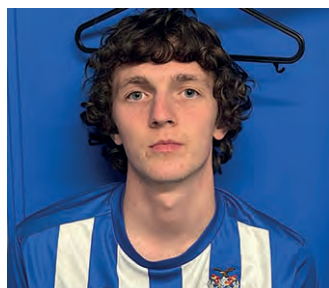

VISITING THE BROOK

BERKS COUNTY

As it stands, if Berks County can win all their games in hand then they will be within four points of runaway Cherry Red Records Combined Counties League Division One leaders Amersham Town.

Generally, joint managers Lee Simpson and Ellis Woods will be reasonably pleased with their club's start to the 2023-24 campaign.

They are in fourth position, occupying a play-off spot having won nine of their 13 matches, which includes a 3-2 defeat at Penn & Tylers Green last weekend. This followed a disappointing 4-2 setback against Westside while their last victory was a 3-0 home success against Bedfont where Ellis Day, Nick Thurmwood and an own goal were on the scoresheet.

Berks County were founded as a youth club in 2009 and the senior side was formed as a merger between Bracknell Rovers and Sunninghill Saints in 2014.

"A lot of the symptoms other people who have had with it, my body is kind of defying it at the moment," Brown says, referring to the benefits of having played non-league football for so many years."

Brown admits he misses the changing room banter, but the bonds he made will be on show tomorrow afternoon as the non-league community pull together for one of their own. Campbell, Francis Duku, Duane Lee, Adrian Toppin and Carl Wilson Dennis will feature for Darty's All Stars, while the likes of Bobby Behzadi, Dale Binns, Richard Pacquette, Mark Nesbit and Ashley Smith will turn out for the Magpies.

Doors open at midday for a 3pm kick-off, while there will be food and drink available, raffles and auctions as well as a bouncy castle.

Duku's Our Game Community Scheme CIC has donated prizes for the auction, while Kingstonian chairman Mark Anderson is providing a coach to take people from west London to the game.
