

GROUND REGULATIONS AT FARM PARK, KINGSHILL AVENUE, HAYES, MIDDLESEX, UB4 8DD TEL: 020 8845 0110

All persons entering the ground must comply with the following **Ground Regulations**.

Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the ground and a ban from attending any future events in the ground.

Admission and the right to remain within the ground is on condition that all persons refrain from the following acts:

1. Failure to comply with any legal directions given by a club official, steward or police officer.
2. Entering the field of play before, during or after the game.
3. Using obscene or abusive language.
4. Making racial or other forms of abuse.
5. Consuming alcohol in bottles, glasses, cans or any other container within the ground boundary. The taking of drugs or being under

the influence of drugs.

6. Climbing on any building, wall, fence or floodlights.
7. The use of horns, hooters or any musical instrument that will affect the enjoyment of others.
8. No animals permitted in the ground with the exception of guide dogs.
9. The throwing of any missile, object or projectile.

In addition all emergency exits, walkways and approaches to the ground must be kept clear at all times.

The club committee reserves the right to amend, add to or update these regulations as and when necessary.





MIDDLESEX FA PREMIER CUP

The Middlesex FA Premier has now reached the business with the semi-finals taking place this week.

Brook House are hosting British Airways while tomorrow evening another Cherry Red Records Combined Counties League Division One side Rising Ballers Kensington take on Kensington Dragons at home.

The Premier Cup is the main county competition for sides at Step Six and Seven but is open to reserve sides and Under-23s of senior clubs.

It was established in 1980 and the first winners were Yeading while Wealdstone Reserves have won this cup the most times. The current holders are Rayners Lane, who also clinched promotion last season to the CCL Premier Division North.

In the quarter-finals, British Airways had a walkover win against Hillingdon Borough while Brook House defeated Shepherds Bush 14-13 in a penalty-mark competition.

The role of a non-league football club chairman is an unforgiving one at the best of times.

Making sure the manager is happy, the fans are satisfied and the hard-working staff or volunteers have got all they need, it's all about keeping the ship sailing on the right course.

Well, for Oldham Athletic chairman Frank Rothwell that has quite literally been the case.

By the time you read this, the 73-year-old – yes SEVENTY THREE – should have completed his epic row across the Atlantic Ocean from the Canary Islands to Antigua.

It's all to raise money for Alzheimer's Research UK – as he told The NLP last week, while stranded 400 miles off the Antigua coast waiting for change in the weather!

"We've had terrible conditions for ocean rowing," Rothwell reported back. "Three years ago, I completed this journey in 56 days. This time I expected to finish in 49 days but we're now on day 51 and I've still got 400 miles to go. I'm going backwards now because the wind has changed direction and is blowing me the wrong way. I'm in a big current which is very contrary to the direction I was going, which is a bit of a pain."

Indeed, it's been far from an easy ride for the Latics chief, who has lost personal items at sea, capsized no fewer than three times and suffered both nausea and motion sickness.

However, for a man who left school aged 14 to repair tractors, then built a multi-million-pound business, has overcome prostate cancer and rescued his hometown club Oldham from bankruptcy after their relegation from the Football League in July 2022, he will not let these problems deter him.

"It's hard on the body, and really hard on the mind, particularly when you start going backwards," he adds. "The boat has rolled over three times! Hopefully the wind will change, but at the moment I'm 400 miles from Antigua sat here on an anchor. I throw a parachute and 100m of rope in the sea that holds the boat in this position against the sea."

It's in those moments Rothwell can think of the difference he is making in undertaking his mission. He is raising money for Alzheimer's Research UK in their bid to fund research to combat dementia.

It's a cause close to Rothwell's heart having lost his best friend, brother-in-law, and several close friends and relatives to dementia in recent years.

Last year, he raised £1.1 million and has so far collected £220,000 of his £1 million target with the football club backing his bid from the confines of Boundary Park.

"Dementia is becoming far more prevalent as we're becoming older nations," Rothwell explained. "I'm 73 and rowing an ocean solo at an age where our parents' generation died, so more people are living to old age and catching dementia."

"My best friend Phil died of Alzheimer's, my brother-in-law Roger died when I was at sea last time, there's five people in the last four years who are friends or relatives who have died from it. There's more people dying of dementia than of any other disease in the UK, we all want to do some good if we can do for a cause."
