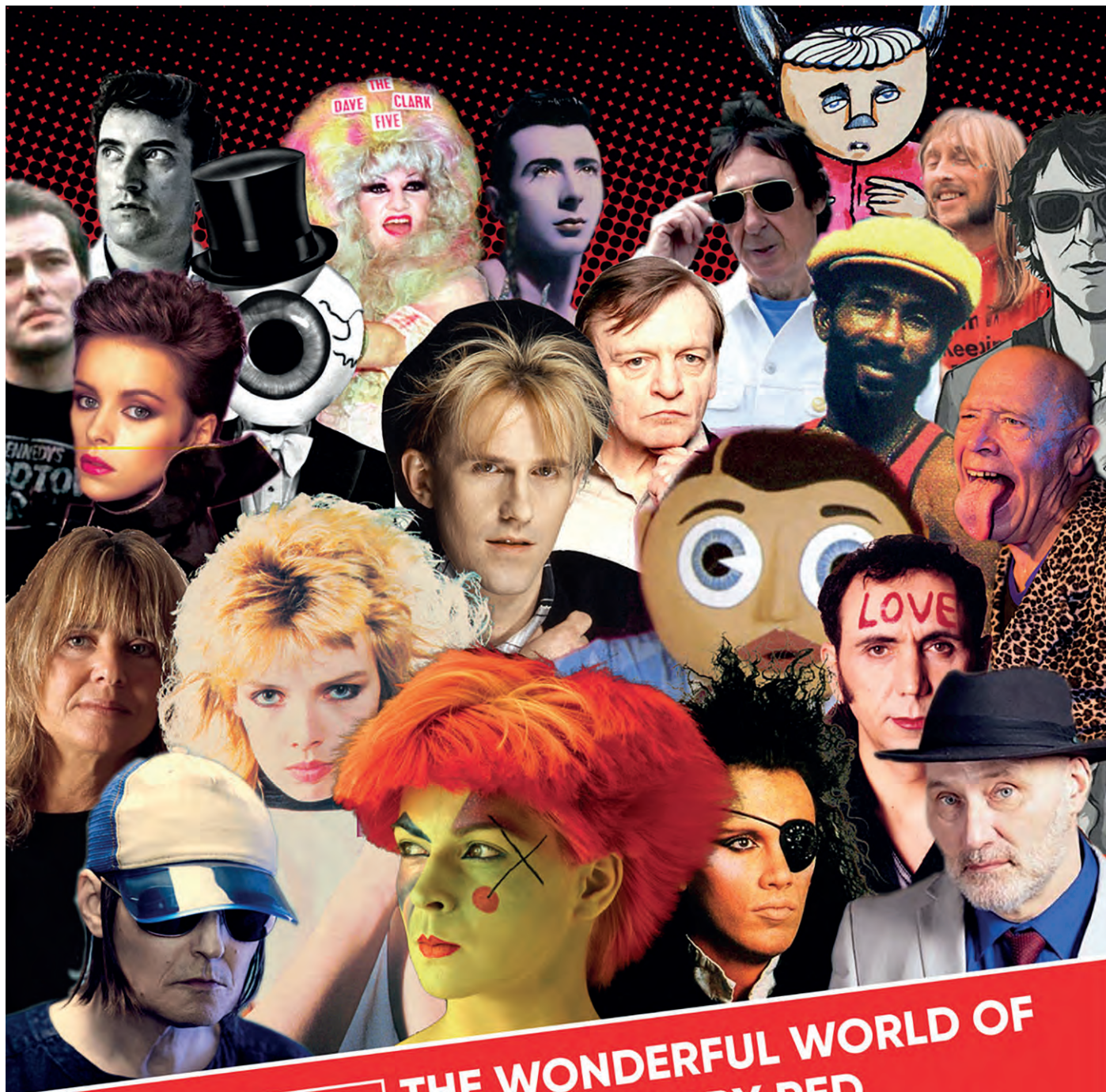

## GROUND REGULATIONS AT FARM PARK, KINGSHILL AVENUE, HAYES, MIDDLESEX, UB4 8DD TEL: 020 8845 0110

All persons entering the ground must comply with the following **Ground Regulations**.

Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the ground and a ban from attending any future events in the ground.

Admission and the right to remain within the ground is on condition that all persons refrain from the following acts:

1. Failure to comply with any legal directions given by a club official, steward or police officer.

9. The throwing of any missile, object or projectile.

## HILLINGDON BOROUGH

Hillingdon Borough are grateful to current Swansea City winger Yannick Bolasie for their survival.

On 17th January 2017, the club released a statement via their Twitter account that the club would be pulling out of the Southern League Division South & West due to monetary troubles.

However, Bolasie, who played for Hillingdon during the 2006-07 season, contacted the club, with the support of Everton, to help with the club's financial situation.

Hillingdon Borough survived and Bolasie stayed at Everton until 2021.

In recent times, Hillingdon Borough have had a difficult time in the Cherry Red Records Combined Counties League Division One.

They started this campaign well but have slipped down the table to second from bottom.

Hillingdon Borough was originally founded as Yiewsley in 1872 after a meeting of eight local businessmen who met at the instigation of Freddie Clinch, a baker of Fairfield Road, Yiewsley who provided the majority of the financial backing for the venture.

On 1st May 1964, the FA Council granted permission for Yiewsley to change their name to Hillingdon Borough FC. This was done to reflect the local government reorganisation in London that was to see the formation of the London Borough of Hillingdon on 1st April 1965.

Southend United's protracted takeover continues to have a major impact. While a deal has been struck between current owner Ron Martin and the new consortium led by Justin Rees, it is yet to be completed.

And that means the on-going registration embargo stands. That saw manager Kevin Maher only able to name one substitute against Bromley recently.

So when keeper David Martin picked up an injury in the game, full-back Gus Scott-Morriss had to don the gloves. They only lost 2-1 but you have to feel for the players and fans as they do all they can to get through. The situation needs resolving pronto!

## GREENS FOR GO

The FA Trophy can get a bit of stick at times. But anyone doubting what it means to many should read Hendon manager Lee Allinson's quotes after they set-up a fourth round date with National League Oldham Athletic.

"People don't see what goes on behind the scenes. I work closely with dad (Ian Allinson), because he's obviously the general manager, and Cyrus Cooper, the chairman, and they work so hard to get sponsorship in to make sure we have a football club.

"That's the reality of it, at the end of the day. To make sure at the start of every season, Hendon Football Club is still there. That's the most important thing. The stress they all go through, to give them this game, hopefully earn a bit of money, it's just a great day out for us."
